Career Fellows Program 2025

Thank you for being interested in MLK Community Healthcare's Career Fellows Program. This annual program is a 7-week health related high school internship and mentorship program that provides students in the community of South LA a meaningful experience by expanding their knowledge to a variety of careers in healthcare. When can I apply?

All applications open from March 31, 2025 – April 25, 2025. No late applications will be accepted.

Who can apply?

Current High school students in grades 10th – 12th who are enrolled in a high school located in South LA.

When does the program start?

This 7-week program runs from June 23, 2025 to August 7, 2025.

What is the schedule for participants?

This in-person internship is from Monday-Thursday from 9am - 3pm during the summer for 7 weeks.

How do I make myself stand out in my application?

We are looking for participants who have a passion for healthcare! Be open about the ways or ideas you have that better the health of your community.

Can I apply if I am a senior who will be graduating?

Yes, but please keep in mind your summer commitments.

Can I apply if I am a rising sophomore in high school?

Students must be a sophomore, junior, or senior by the time the application deadline closes. We encourage you to apply next year!

If I have another commitment, how many days am I allowed to miss?

The program allows you to miss up to three days. A notice ahead of time is needed.
